

St Moritz – Top of the World

February 26 – March 2, 2008, guided trip

Alpine Ski and cross country Skiing

St. Moritz is one of the most renowned holiday resorts of the world. Chic, elegant and exclusive with a pronouncedly cosmopolitan ambiance it is situated at 5624 ft (1856 m) above sea level, in the middle of the lake-dotted landscape of the Upper Engadin. The dry, sparkling champagne climate has become legendary and the famous sun of St. Moritz shines on an average of 322 days a year. St. Moritz is the cradle of alpine winter tourism (1864) and sports (1884). It was home of two Olympic Winter Games and a great number of ski and bob sledding championships. It was at the hub of winter sports competitions again in 2003 when hosting the Alpine Ski World Championship

The sun of St. Moritz is more intense (southern exposure!), the "champagne climate" dryer and the snow much more likely to hold than anywhere else. These components, along with the lakescape and valley groove of the Upper Engadin, provide the background for a host of attractions which are unique with regard to quality and diversity: alpine and Nordic cross-country skiing (marathon!), Cresta Run, Bob Sled Run, horse and greyhound races on the frozen lake, cricket, polo, golf tournaments and Olympic ski jump.



Skiing St Moritz/Engadin

Engadin/St.Moritz is Switzerland's largest winter sports region, with 350 kilometers of slopes in nine different skiing areas! Corviglia, Corvatsch, Diavolezza are synonymous with breathtaking and unforgettable skiing experiences. 60 modern skier transportation facilities open up on 350 km of snow-covered runs at altitudes from 1800 to 3300 meters above sea level. You, too, are bound to find your favourite mountain here! From the well-known skiing areas, located close to everything, to the smaller family ski lifts. A great many panoramic restaurants, ski huts, and snow bars invite you to enjoy ambiance and exciting après-ski fun. You will always have a view of the incomparable lakes region of the Engadin in your sight.

Cross Country St Moritz/Engadin

There are a total of 180km of Nordic-ski trails prepared according to the highest standards and cutting across the landscape of the Upper Engadin as well as leading into innumerable, romantic side valleys. No matter whether you are training in order to participate in the Ski Marathon, whether you wish to test your limits on the racing trails or whether you prefer to glide along the illuminated night trails when the hour is late, the Engadin has the right trail for every disposition



Engadin Ski Marathon on March 9, 2008

The Engadin Ski Marathon has been held annually since 1969 on the second Sunday of March. The race is open to the public and all who wish to take up the challenge of covering the classic marathon distance of 42km are welcome to participate in this mass event. More than 13 000 people are starting from Maloja down to the whole valley to Zuoz. Here everything is very well organised: everyone feels like a champion. This marathon is a real event, a phenomenon, an adventure and a challenge for each and every participant. Even though a single individual may not appear as anything larger than a tiny dot in this mass of people, the involvement in the sheer magnitude of this celebration makes everyone feel as if they were giants themselves.

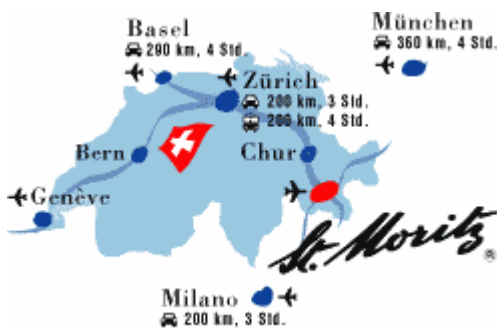
